I can't believe March is already here. I am looking forward to the spring, especially every day as I walk by our sleeping garden... I can hardly wait to see our children, staff, and community working together this planting season. There are also many exciting events happening at Green Gables this month including a Family Science Night, 1st and 2nd grade music program, and a Restorative Practices Parent Information Session. Be sure to look on our school website for specific dates on the calendar. Our school is also in the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Downtown Denver on March 17th. We are the Leprechauns after all! I hope you can join us for the parade to show our Green Gables Pride. This is a long standing tradition and I am certainly looking forward to being a part of it.

Spring State Assessments are also right around the corner. The CMAS (Colorado Measures of Academic Success) determine a student's achievement and academic growth in English Language Arts, Math, and Science in relation to the Colorado Academic Standards. Each area of CMAS is a timed assessment and is given annually each spring. The following grade levels are assessed:

Grade Levels Assessed

Grades 3 - 6 - English Language Arts and Math
Grades 5 - Science

As we get closer to the assessment window, look for information in your child's Friday folder, along with tips for supporting your child with standardized tests. The spring testing window is open from March 19th –April 27th. We encourage all families to schedule vacations and appointments around the scheduled testing dates. We have minimal make-up days restricted to a specific window scheduled for students who are ill or absent for unavoidable reasons.

Kindergarten teachers will be asking their families to donate \$10 to cover the cost of graduation supplies, cake, and refreshments.



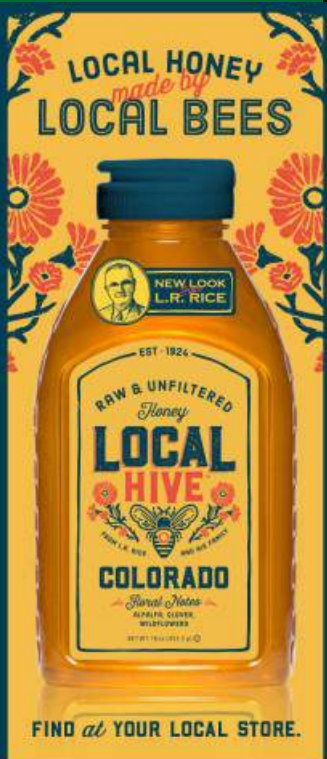
